DIAPERS & WIPES INSTRUCTIONS

Volunteers will assemble diaper and wipe packs that are provided to families at Van Buren.

Diapers

- Rubber band diapers of the same size in sets of 5.
- Put the rubber band diapers back into the diaper box they came from,
 so we know what size they are.
- Volunteers will put completed rubber band diaper boxes inside our secured diaper cage located in the warehouse.

Wipes

- Take 1/4 inch of wipes from the sealed packages and place them into zip-lock bags.
- Put zip-lock bags with wipes into red bins.
- When the grey bin is full, put a printed label on the size of the red bin (most will have an old sticker on it still; place a new sticker over).
- Volunteers will put completed baggie wipes inside our diaper cage located in the warehouse.

HOW ITEMS ARE DISTRIBUTED

100% of the diapers and wipes provided to families at Van Buren are received through donations. Diapers and wipes are stocked at the Front Desk for families to access when needed.

DIAPER & WIPES NEEDS

Did you know that diapers and wipes are not eligible for purchase with SNAP benefits?

The Van Buren Center is always in high need of donations of baby wipes and diapers, specifically size 4, 5, and 6. These are items we continually run out of or are low on, resulting in our families having to go without or rely on other community resources with limited quantites.
