



I-15 CENTRAL CORRIDOR

Welcome!

Thank you for attending the Nevada Department of Transportation's (NDOT) I-15 Central Corridor Public Meeting. This public meeting kicks off NDOT's environmental study for proposed improvements along I-15 between I-215 (Southern Beltway) and Oakey Boulevard and is intended to reintroduce you to the design alternatives developed as part of the 2021 feasibility study prepared for the I-15 Central Corridor.

The existing I-15 Central Corridor from Flamingo to Sahara only accommodates five through lanes in each direction, while future demands are expected to further impact I-15 traffic operations within the study area. The 2021 feasibility study allowed NDOT to identify preliminary alternatives primarily focused on safety and traffic operation improvements necessary to accommodate future traffic demands.

Tonight, NDOT is conducting this in-person public information meeting in an open house format from 4pm to 7pm, with a formal presentation at 5:30 pm.

Please review the various displays and exhibits around the room that provide information about the project, what's been done to date, and what's next, and how to stay involved. You can submit written comments on the form included in this packet and place the form in the comment box at the check-in table, make verbal comments following the presentation, or visit the court reporter's table to submit a verbal statement.

Comments may also be submitted to me via mail or email. The comment period will remain open until 5pm, Friday, Feb. 16, 2024.
