...Our 3rd district supervisor, Joan Hartman, helped adopt what is called a project labor agreement that freezes out all non-union contractors from bidding on county construction projects. 85% of all construction firms in SB County are non-union.

...Efforts by the Santa Barbara County supervisors to allow hikers, joggers, dogs, and cyclists to co-exist with horseback riders for the first time on the Live Oak Trail north of Lake Cachuma have failed - for the time being. This is GREAT news for our Equestrian Community, those who support due process, and the plaintiffs -- whose legal fees must now be covered by the county costing taxpayers \$300,000!

....<u>AB 1797</u> became a law in California on January 1, 2023. The state will have all of your vaccination information in a government data registry to use at their disposal.

There is no opt out.

....<u>SB 1419</u> became law in California on January 1, 2023. Prohibits the representative of a minor from inspecting the minor's patient record when the records relate to certain services, including medical care related to the prevention or treatment of pregnancy, as specified.




