- The Gothic Revival Alban Towers from 1927 (featuring a stone arch support carving of Charles Lindberg, who had just completed his solo transatlantic flight when the building was completed)
- The Art Moderne Marlyn from 1938 by architect Francis Koenig
- Some of the small elegant garden apartments of architect George Santmyers
- We'll conclude the tour with a visit to the manicured gardens, architecture and lobbies of the Westchester Co-op, a well-kept secret that is surely one of Washington's finest apartment complexes.

Limited on street parking is available and we'll be close to the Wisconsin Avenue Metrobus lines.
