## Watering

Hanging baskets are more exposed to more wind and warmer temperatures, which tends to make them dry out faster then bed planted plants. Check soil daily. Water deeply when the top two inches of soil are dry.

## **Fertilizing**

Are you noticing yellow leaves or poor flowers...

The plant is sending you a message that it needs more light or fertilizing. Use a water-solube fertilizer It helps keep your plant at half strength every time you water or when you first get your hanging basket, sprinkle over the soil one or two tablespoons of Osmocote. Usually they are aready done for you. This helps keep the plant well fed through the season.

## **Grooming**

For best appearance and to encourage flowering, remove spent blossoms and seedpods. If plant become overr grown then trim them back.

(TIP): Try Jacks blossom booster, for great color through thr season. It is what we use here in are lines at Massi's.
