

Planting Guidelines

Dig a hole one and half times as wider than the container
Follow the instruction on back of Bio-tone bag to help stimulate the roots
Place the nessisary amount in the hole before planting
Remove container. Roughen sides, bottom and top of the rootball
Place tree in the hole with the trunk straight
Fill soil around the areas needed
Water throughly

Add 3 inches of mulch around the tree, but not close to the trunk Water as needed to maintain evenly moist soil Staking is beneficial for larger trees or windy sites. Remove after 1 year

SHRUB PLANTING

Top of root ball flush or slightly



Root ball slightly loosened or intact

Back fill with 2/3 native soil & 1/3 compost + Biotone

TREE PLANTING

Dig a hole no deeper than the root ball and twice as wide.

Remove the pot before planting.

This bump on the trunk is where it was grafted. Never plant graft below soil level.

Plant at the depth of the original soil line while in container. See Fig. B

The first roots are just below the soil line.

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
