These are just a few words recently received from camper families who attend Flying Horse Farms, showing their appreciation for what our very generous and talented donors and volunteers do. This year **847 quilts and 635 pillowcases** were taken home by campers and families.

As of mid-November, the total gifts to all organizations supported in 2025 have been **1102 quilts and 1084 pillowcases**. Flannel donated to Snuggled was made into 137 receiving blankets and 315 burp cloths for distribution. 115 superhero capes, 272 rice bags, and 155 port pillows completed the donations. Next year we anticipate celebrating the ***** 10,000***** mark of quilts and pillowcases gifted since Snuggled in Hope Quilts was founded. That is a lot of stitches made with love.

Our mission statement says, "children with needs". While the majority of our sewing is for the younger range, we believe "children" is an age range of birth until death. As we have done for many years, December will bring the choice at sewing events to step away from our regular projects, if desired. We will be making some simple adult clothing protectors and walker bags for a local nursing facility. We will provide all the necessary supplies. If you prefer to work on tops, that is perfectly fine, we will have those available, too. Christmas is, after all, the spirit of love and generosity and goodness and doing a little extra for someone.
