

# MY TOWN HOUSE TREE BLOCK

Size: 51/2" x 7"

Making Camp a Cozier Place!



#### Fabric needed for a block:

- 2 print charms
- 1 for the tree and 1 for the trunk
  (Note: you can cut several trunks cut from one 5" charm square)


### **Background fabric**


- Two − 2½" x 3" rectangles, One 1" x 4" rectangles
- Two − 1¼" x 4½" rectangles

Four - 1¼" squares

## **Cutting:**

- For the "tree" fabric, you will need:
  - One 4" Square
- For the "trunk" fabric, you will need:
  - $\circ$  One 1½" x 3" rectangle.
- If cutting from a charm square, you can get four trunks cut from one charm as shown in the cutting diagram.








**NOTE:** You will notice in my blocks that I mixed up the doors and roofs in each block to make them even more scrappy


#### **Block Assembly:**

- Select your 4" tree square and four 1¼" background squares.
- Sew a 11/4" background square to the tree square as shown below, trim and press.
- Continue to sew the remaining 1¼" background squares to each of the tree corners, trim and press.











- To complete the tree, select the following:
  - One 1" x 4" background rectangle
  - Two 1¼" x 4½" background rectangles
  - Two 2½" x 3" background rectangles
  - One 1½" x 3" trunk rectangle
- Sew the 1" x 4" background rectangle to the top of the pieced tree section.
- Sew the two 1 1/4" x 4 1/2" background rectangles to each side of the pieced tree section.
- Sew the two 2 1/2" x 3" background rectangles to each side of the trunk.
   Sew the pieced trunk section to the bottom of the pieced tree section.
