
## Cooperative Dynamics Workshop!

Cooperative Leadership Camp (CLC) graduates who are in their senior year of high school are invited to apply for the Jim Graham Scholarship for the 2020 year. ## **Cooperative Leadership Camp: Also open ONLINE Now!** **June 15-19, 2020 White Lake, NC**

Cooperative Leadership Camp (CLC) will take place again at the FFA Center at White Lake, NC. We will have a bus that runs the state Monday to pick up teens to bring them to camp then back on Friday. Camp is in its 7th decade of production hosted by the Cooperative Council of North Carolina. We take Cooperative employees and High School teachers as camp staff and bring college students as Jr. Staffers for the week. The five day four night camp is a sponsored opportunity for teens, which means a member cooperative, 4H or FFA organization pays for each selected teen to attend camp at no charge to the teen. The teen can apply to CCNC, their Cooperative or their 4H/FFA organization.

CLC includes all the different sectors of cooperatives in our state with workshops so the teens can see what co-ops do, how they do it and why they are so special. The teens elect a board of directors, divide into working departments and design, produce and distribute tee-shirts in a teen lead worker/owner tee shirt cooperative. They learn the 7 cooperative principles, work through business challenges and work together to understand how a cooperative functions.

By the end of camp the teens host an annual meeting, share their department reports and the vote to dissolve their cooperative (since they are leaving camp). The teens get co-op challenges (real life business problems) that promote decision making based on their by-laws and the 7 cooperative principles that they have learned. All challenges are decided in a democratic manner with one vote per worker/owner in the tee shirt cooperative. **Applications for adults and teens are now open online at [www.ccnc.coop](http://www.ccnc.coop)**
