ESL Summer Immersion

The Brampton program provides European teenagers with the opportunity to experience life in Canada as part of a family.

It has been a very rewarding experience for both the homestay families and the students.

The students come for 3 weeks (20 nights) in July or August.

The students stay in families in the GTA and surrounding areas.

The homestay families will be visited by our local coordinators and submit a police check.

Since this is an immersion program, there must be one adult at home during the day. The students will spend most of their time with their homestay families, sharing in their everyday activities, and becoming part of the family.

The students have two organized activities each week: full day trips every Tuesday and Friday.

The company is responsible for organizing and paying for these activities. The homestay families will drop off their students to meet our chartered school bus at a local meeting point.

The full day trips will include (1) to Toronto and the CN Tower, (2) to Niagara Falls for a boat ride to the foot of the Falls, and (3) to Canada's Wonderland. Sometimes children in the homestay families accompany their students on the full day trips.
