

How Much Do You Know?

- A common reason for ladder accidents is failure to inspect ladders before use.
- The base of a straight ladder should be 1 foot from the wall for every 2 feet of ladder height from base to support point.
- If a ladder is defective, return it to where you found it and take another ladder.
- •It is safe to stand on the top step of a stepladder. PALSE

3 Most Common Causes of Ladder Accidents

Wrong ladders used

Ladder in poor condition

Ladder used improperly

Additional Causes of Ladder Accidents

Carrying tools in one or both hands

Wet or oily shoes

Straight ladders are not secured

Failure to Inspect / Lack of Training

5 Steps to Reduce the Risk of Falls

1. Inspect Ladders Before Use

2. Follow Ladder Safety Rules

3. Only One Employee At A Time

4. Avoid Risky Behavior

5. Remove Faulty Ladders

Ladder Selection

WEIGHT CAPACITY

Also known as duty rating or load capacity

Make sure the weight of the user plus the materials carried are less than the weight capacity.

Type 3

200 lbs.

LIGHT DUTY

Household use

Type 2

225 lbs.

MEDIUM DUTY

Painter & handyman, simple projects Type 1

250 lbs.

HEAVY DUTY

Industrial, handles most jobs and projects

Type 1A

300 lbs.

EXTRA HEAVY DUTY

Industrial, designed for professional use Type 1AA

375 lbs.

SUPER DUTY


Maximum durability for tough professional or home use



- Hold on
- Keep centered
- Stay straight and close to the ladder
- Move carefully




Ladder Maintenance

- Check joints
- Test hardware and fittings
- Lubricate moveable parts
- Replace worn rope on extension ladders
- Make sure safety feet are in good condition
- Clean rungs and steps



Storing Ladders



Transporting Ladders

- Pair up
- Balance the center on your shoulder
- Be careful around corners, aisles, or where others are working



Ladders should not stick out of vehicles
