

### Hazard Identification



#### • Goals

- Establish shared understanding of the most common Key Risk Conditions and what can go wrong
- Provide mitigation measures
- Define who is responsible

# Key Risk Conditions: Always and Never

### FLOW CONTROL GROUP

#### • Always:

- Perform a HSE Toolbox Talk and work with a permit or safe system of work
- Use the correct tools for the job
- Use the correct Personal Protective Equipment
- Intervene when you see an unsafe act
- Adhere to site speed limits and driving requirements

#### • Never:

- Remove safety isolation / equipment barriers
- Walk under a suspended load
- Be exposed to a fall or work at height without protection
- Expose yourself or others to the risk of dropped objects
- Perform tasks for which you are not trained
