We, the undersigned citizens of Langford are protesting the projected development proposal for 647 Goldstream Ave. because the project is out of **scale** with the size of our neighbourhood. TWIN 11-Story Towers - 224 apartment units are too high a **density** for existing infrastructure. We protest because **parking** is already an issue for Fairway Ave. It is too narrow a street, without sidewalks, for cars to park **safely** and **pedestrian safety** is an issue. We protest because the **traffic** from another high-density building would add to traffic congestion problems that already exist on Goldstream Ave.
