30-31 of October 2025 – Aerial Art

World Championships all categories: Amateurs & Para

1 of November and 2 of November 2025 – Aerial Art

World Championships all categories: Competitive & Para

The starting order of the competition will be made between the 15th and 20 of October 2025 by the official representatives of POSA after the deadline for athlete applications (28 September 2025 with the exception of Italy which has a deadline until October 13th cause to the National Aerial Art Competition) has closed. Other countries that may have the same needs should contact the organization.

Registrations open on 15 May 2025 and close on 28 September 2025.

If a National Federation reduces the number of participating athletes after the definitive inscriptions, POSA/TC has the right to adjust the starting order to ensure the best possible running of the competition.

Awards ceremonies

The ceremonies at the competition venue will take place as mentioned in the schedule.

Aerial Supplier and Equipment

Official Sponsor of Aerial Equipment is **Apole Company**.

The competition stage will be equipped with professional aerial equipment: 7 meters high open-topped. For the preparation of the routine, account must be taken of the subtraction of 30 cm for the coupling device and the height of the mat. This way the maximum usable height is 6.30 meters for the silk and hammock and 6.50 for the hoop.

All athletes are requested to bring their apparatus (Silk, Hammock and/or Hoop)

Apole Company will provide a Hoop (standard size) and a Silk, however we recommend that you bring your own apparatus.

Crash Mat 200*200 meters 20 cm thick (Mandatory)

Crash Mat 200*200 meters 40 cm thick will be also available and mandatory for Silk and Hammock.

Access to the competition area

The competition area is accessible to the members of the various juries, competing athletes and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the President of the POSA, Medical Commission, the official doctor, the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus. A team medical person is permitted to accompany the athletes and coaches during all Competitions.

Scoring and distribution of results

Once the competition has finished, by request, all delegations will be provided with a complete set of results (Difficulty only) by e-mail. However, requests must be sent to the international federation within one week after the end of the competition, after that date, it will no longer be possible. (Please refer carefully to the Rules & Regulations 2025).

Music

To limit the technical problems with the music used for the competitions, the Organizing Committee has decided to only accept the athletes' music in an MP3 or MP4 format only. All music used during the World Aerial Art Championships 2025 must be submitted online.

Athletes must send their music by October 20th via email to posachampionship@gmail.com

Each music file will have to contain the following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category;
- The length of the music;
- (Example: ROU_ RADU_Alina_Junior_IW_3min30s_mp3 or mp4)

In addition, the competitors need to bring their music with them to the venue on the competition day on an USB stick as a backup.

Attention: Incorrectly named music file will receive a warning from the Head Judge (as per the Code of Points).

Doping control

Any doping is prohibited. A doping control can be done to the athletes at any time, without a pre-warning, in accordance with POSA regulations. Doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the WADA regulations.

- 1 Head Judge fixed by Draw
- 2 Technical Judges fixed by Draw
- 3 Artistic Judges fixed by Draw
- 1 Execution Judge fixed by Draw

Tie-breaking rule.

In case of a tie at any position at the end of a competition see POSA Aerial Art Rules & Regulations.

In general terms, we remind you that the athlete with the highest score in the artistic section will go up.

Definition of Amateur Athlete.

For this definition, see the POSA Aerial Art Rules & Regulations.

POSA has decided that to define and differentiate an Amateur athlete from a Competitive athlete, the POSA Code of Points will be used as an example: An amateur athlete is defined as one who must perform on the Aerial, only elements that have a value up to 0.5 of the POSA Scoring Code. However, amateur athletes may perform a maximum of one element with a value higher than 0.5. Athletes who break this rule will automatically and immediately be placed and evaluated in the Competitive category.

THE ORGANIZATION OF THE EVENT

Delegations

The following athletes are eligible to participate in the World Aerial Art 2025:

1. Athletes matching the guidelines of the 2025 Rules & Regulations (POSA Aerial Art Rules & Regulations)
2. The first 3 classified (Amateurs and Competitive) of the 2024 and/or 2025 National Aerial Art Championships (Depending on when the qualifying competition was organised)
3. All those automatically admitted by the International Federation (Wild Card Athletes).

Registration and accreditation

Each athlete needs to have a competition WHEA/POSA license with approved anti-doping contract 2025.

Athletes must do their registration at latest on 30th of July. All documentation must be sent by the deadline to posachampionship@gmail.com

The documents to be sent by e-mail are:

- Competitive medical certificate (8 years and older)
- Identity card or passport
- AICS membership card (only for Italian athletes) and private insurance for foreign athletes. **The organization reserves the right to carry out the necessary checks on the insurance documentation. Only documents in English will be accepted.**
- Athlete registration form by national federation
- SELF-DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT
- Bank Transfer for spectator tickets and entry fee (athlete and coach)

Accreditation permits the identification of all participants and indicates the access to certain zones. Access to all zones will be controlled. Accreditation bracelet must be visibly worn throughout the whole event. The accreditation bracelet is personal, non-transferable, and necessary to access the training and competition halls.

Accreditation will be carried out upon arrival. During the accreditation the athletes and/or the Heads of Delegations will verify the identity of the members of their delegation. To get the accreditation all members of the delegation must have fulfilled all the necessary financial obligations (including insurance).

POSA Directives and Technical Regulations will be strictly applied, especially to the number of persons accredited per nation.

Opening ceremony

The Official Opening Ceremony for Aerial Art athletes will be held on October 30th for all Aerial Art categories, in the Competition Hall.

The ceremony will consist of Flags Presentation by nation with the competitors by nation performing a special greeting for the audience. All competitors must wear their national tracksuit.

All delegations must have the National Flag (dimension of 100/200 cm) with them on Opening ceremony.

The opening ceremony is mandatory.

At least five athletes per delegation must be present at the ceremony.

Competition Area

Access to the competition area

- The competition area is accessible to the members of the various juries, competing athletes and their accredited coaches, local group leaders, auxiliary personnel of the Jury, the Medical Commission, and persons concerned with the apparatus.
- Interpreters may not enter the competition area without the permission of the President of Posa.
- The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons.
- The use of any kind of electronic devices (video, mobile phones, etc.) is strictly forbidden in the competition area. Please note that, according to the decision of the Executive Committee of POSA, if a mobile phone or any other electronic communication device is used in the competition area during the entire competition, the person concerned (athlete and/or coach) will be immediately expelled. The athlete will not be ranked and will not be authorized to participate in the remaining competitions. If this rule is violated by a coach, all his/her athletes will also be expelled.

Professional photographing and filming of the performances are under written permission from the organizing committee.

Official POSA Hotels

The stay at the Acrobatic Academy is strongly recommended. Those who will not stay (athletes and coaches) at the academy must pay a fee of 20 euros per day to access the venue.

How to arrive to Cesenatico



Cesenatico is a characteristic place of the riviera that combines history, culture and good living. In the small and picturesque old town you can still breathe the atmosphere of the old fishing village, between the canal port and the alleys where there are museums, restaurants, markets and charming places.

The reference airport is Bologna.

From Bologna to Cesenatico:

By car: 1 hour (99,3 km) via E45. Take the exit of Cesena and continue in the direction of Cesenatico for about 8 kilometers; then take the SS16 (direction Rimini) until the exit of Cesenatico and continue to Zadina locality.

By train from Bologna Centrale



Insurance

POSA Technical Regulations stipulate that all participating federations or athletes must assume all costs of the medical insurance of all delegation members (illness and accidents). The Local Organizing Committee has the right to verify the validity of the insurance upon arrival of the delegations (policy insurance, original or copy in english language).

Entering the World Championships without valid medical insurance for all delegation members will be rejected.

Visa

Please check whether you need a visa to enter Italy. The Local Organizing Committee will gladly assist you in applying for a visa. The assist must be requested no later than 1th of September to: contact@posaworld.org

Video & photos


