GUIDE FOR BUILDING PERMITS

Williams County Requires Building Permits For The Following:

- 1. New Home
- 2. Garage
- 3. Any addition to an existing structure
- 4. Construction of Decks, Patios, or Porches
- 5. Siding or Replacement of Siding
- 6. Replacement Windows
- 7. Finish of an attic or basement into living area in an existing structure
- 8. Utility sheds that consist of an area of 150 sq. ft. or greater, despite if placed on skids or a permanent foundation
- 9. Changing of any Roof Line

Lake Seneca Requires Building and/or Excavation Permits for the Following:

- 1. New Home
- 2. Garage
- 3. Any addition to an existing structure
- 4. Construction of Decks, Patios, or Porches (Per Deed Restriction #3)
- 5. Siding or Replacement of Siding
- 6. Replacement Windows
- 7. Finish of an attic or basement into living area in an existing structure
- 8. Utility sheds that consist of an area of 150 sq. ft. or greater, despite if placed on skids or a permanent foundation
- 9. Changing of Roof Line
- 10. Gazebo (On a permanent foundation is considered 2nd building----Per Deed Restriction #2)
- 11. Dock (Maximum length 30 ft.)
- 12. Fence (Also needs approval by the Board)
- 13. Seawall
- 14. Filling of Ditch (Minimum 8 inch Tile Required)
- 15. Excavation
- 16. Driveway (Minimum 8 inch Tile per Township/County Requirements) (Deed Restriction #7 for Easements)

No Building Permit is Required:

- 1. Steps to lake (Contact ODNR for regulations)
- 2. Car-Ports (No permanent foundations; must be able to disassemble and easily move)

As per our ByLaw, page 3, Article 3 D, no one will be issued a building permit when dues are not up to date.
