The Psalms are prophetic. The Jews loved them, yet they did not fully comprehend all the prophecies contained with them. Such is the often-neglected Psalm 65.

Psalm 65:1 says, "Praise is awaiting You, O God..." (NKJV) 65:5b, "...O God of our salvation, You who are the confidence (refuge, security, assurance) of all ends of the earth, and of the far-off seas."

The "ends of the earth" was beyond their scope of knowledge. God's salvation extended to the "far-off seas" where praise is waiting (vs. 1) for the God of our salvation (Yeshua, Jesus) in the Americas. The Jews could not have known this. Yet in the far-off seas beyond Europe, Asia, and Africa, the gospel came to "The New World" where praise awaited for our Lord.

North America, the Caribbean Islands, Central and South America raised much praise to the Lord who had been waiting to receive it as spoken in verse 1, "Praise awaiteth thee, O God." (KJV.)

Yes, Psalm 65:5 prophesied the praise which was fulfilled at the discovery and conversion of the New World of the "far-off seas" over 2,000 years later.

Praise God for that fulfillment. It has brought the gospel of salvation in Yeshuah to you and me!
