DON'T LIMIT GOD

Jesus often rebuked his disciples for not having faith. They saw the miracles of the loaves and fishes, they saw the blind eyes opened, they saw the dead raised, but they still had doubt. I am sure like them that often we think, "well that was Jesus, He could do anything." Yet, He has given you and me authority to do the things He did. We limit God when we don't believe.

Do you realize what he meant in John 14:12-13 where He said, ***"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son."***
