MORAL RELATIVITY

Proverbs 21:2 says, ***“Every way of a man is right in his own eyes, but the LORD pondereth the hearts.”*** This is the pervasive philosophy today of morality. It is called moral relativism, meaning each individual person’s moral standard is only relative to what their own ideas of it may be. They do not believe in moral absolutes. They are free to set their own standards of behavior and ethics. “Nobody can tell me what I must or must not do.” Or “nobody can judge me.”

The New International Version (NIV) says it this way: ***“A person may think their own ways are right, but the LORD weighs the heart.”***

God’s word sets absolute values of morality and ethics. He sees the corruption in the hearts (human spirits) of those convinced that morals are only relative.

This philosophy has been taught in all our public education system since at least 1970, perhaps even before. Those people who were taught this now truly believe it. Right and wrong are often determined by the social mindset of their peers or of the worldly society.

God does not care what they think is okay or not okay. His word sets absolutes and that is how He will judge them.

Let us pray for friends or loved ones who are caught up in this philosophy. Pray God will convict them, and they will search out truth in His word. Pray God will have mercy on them.

Moral relativity is a demonic deception. Our nation has bought into it.
