HAVING DONE ALL STAND

In Ephesians chapter 6 verses 10-17 Paul is teaching the church at Ephesus about spiritual warfare. In verse 12 we learn that the battles we face are not with flesh and blood, but with spiritual entities in high places that use people.

We are commanded to ***“Put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.”*** It is no secret that the enemy wants to “take us out.”
