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WHO IS ANSWERING YOUR DOOR?

Years ago, I heard a very catchy phrase that has stuck with me. I quote it often. It goes like this: "Fear knocked at the door. Faith answered. No one was there." You see my friends, faith eradicates fear.

II Timothy 1:7 tells us: ***"For God hath not give us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind."*** Fear does not come from God. It comes from Satan. We are all put in positions to "fear" but what we do with it will determine our victory or defeat.

In Isaiah 26:3 it says: ***"Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee."*** When we don't trust God, we put our trust in fear. That is a hard pill to swallow, but if you are walking in fear it means that you don't trust God and his promises. Keeping our mind stayed means to have it "fixed" where it is unmovable. Oh yes, fear will knock on the door, but faith must answer. How do we get faith? Faith comes by hearing the word or promises of God. We also build up our faith by praying in the Holy Ghost (Jude v 20).

There is no substitute for faith. You can't buy it at Walmart or Amazon. It is developed like a muscle, by exercising it. It must be a part of your daily life if you want to be free of fear.

The next time fear knocks at your door, let faith answer. No one will be there.
