If this describes yourself or someone you know, then the only thing you can do about it is to repent and change. You must find the promises that God has for you through reading the Word of God that He gives for every situation and believe they are for you and they are for you today. Then you fight the fight of faith through not doubting and keep believing until you receive.

Satan will try to steal the word from you, but you must use the Word of God as your offense and tell him "no." Don't be the one that is double-minded. It will lead to instability in everything you do. Make a decision after prayer and live with it.
