MINISTERING SPIRITS  
PART 2 OF 2

Yesterday, we taught on holy and unholy spirits, or angels of God and demons of Satan. They are all around us, but not in a chaotic fashion. God is orderly and his angels are very organized and structured just like an army would be. Each angel has a certain position and a certain assignment. Not all angels are equal. Likewise, Satan's demons are similarly structured; Satan is a copy-cat.

You have heard it taught that you have a guardian angel. That is true. His specific assignment is for your safety. It is his only job. There may even be more than just one for some people. However, there is more to the role of angels than most people realize. We can see this in Hebrews 1:14 where it speaks of angels, ***“Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister FOR them who shall be heirs of salvation?”*** (Capitals are mine for effect.)

We shall see that they minister on our behalf based on our words, our prayers, our actions, and our faith. They minister for us and not just to us only.

Strong's Greek word “for” is “dia” (G1223). It denotes a channel through which an act is performed. As we pray for a specific action (or miracle, petition, request, or a need), an angel is dispatched by God to bring the answer to fruition. God answers the prayer by sending an angel to do the work. It is by the power of Jesus and the authority He has given to us through His name that the anointing from Holy Spirit flows forth to bring it about, so that the assigned angel can complete the task.

I know this may sound controversial because you may not have been taught in this manner. But it is what this verse, taken with other scriptures, teaches us.

This is why praying in tongues is so important. The Holy Spirit knows the needs of people and can pray through you for those situations. Although you do not know what you are speaking in tongues, the Holy Spirit does and gives an angel an assignment. The words you utter in the heavenly language (tongues) cause The Holy Spirit to act upon them on your behalf. He then assigns an angel who ministers for you.

Of course, the angels also act upon the words that you do speak in your own language and understanding. (i.e. Plain English or your thoughts.) Whether you speak words casually or in prayer, your words are activated in spiritual realms. Choose your words wisely.
