THE "I AM" LESSON 10

At the "Last Supper" Jesus told His disciples of several things that were going to happen, including His betrayal. Why did He tell them? He gives the answer in John 13:19.

"Now I tell you before it comes, [so] that when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I AM." His declaration being the "I AM that I AM" was to solidify their understanding that He is the same God who spoke to Moses through the burning bush.

It was a strong "I AM" statement. Remember the italicized "he" that was erroneously inserted by the human translator. Jesus said, "I AM." He did not say "I am he."

Jesus is truly the great and eternal "I AM" that I AM," the self-existent one. He is God and He lives within us, His children.
