In Luke 21:33 Jesus said, *"Heaven and earth shall pass away (as refined by fire heaven and earth), but my words (logos) shall not pass away."* 

In John 1:1 Jesus is defined as the Word and declares that He, the Word, was God. If we use the Greek word, then verse 1 would read this way (and accurately): *"In the beginning was the Logos, and the Logos was with God, and the Logos was God."*
