BEHOLD THE LAMB PART 3
BIRTH OF THE LAMB OF GOD

When the very pregnant Mary arrived with Joseph in Bethlehem, it was no accident that they could not find a room in an inn. It became obvious that she was about to deliver. There was only one place to be found to take Mary. It was at the sheepfold on Bethlehem's outskirts, the Migdal `Eder.

The sheepfold, tower of the flock [Micah 4:8] was empty because the priestly shepherds had taken the sheep out to the field. This is where Mary delivered Jesus.
