WATCHMEN

In Ezekiel 3:17-19 God is speaking to Ezekiel and says, ***"Son of man, I have made thee a watchman unto the house of Israel: therefore, hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from me. When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity, but his blood will I require at thine hand. Yet if thou warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul."***

Being a watchman is a great responsibility. It requires hearing from God, and it requires giving out a warning to those in sin. If a watchman does not do this, then when the sinner dies, his blood will be required at the Watchman's hand.

One day a person came to my door, and was from a "cult," (those that deny that Jesus came as God in the flesh) and I casually said to them "I have my own church thank you," and I shut the door. Immediately I heard Holy Spirit speak to me with that still small voice. "If you don't give the truth out, I will require their blood at your hand." This put the fear of God into me. I did not exactly understand it, but I knew it would be bad if I didn't obey. From that day on I determined that every person that would come to my door would get the gospel. I determined when God "nudged" me to witness to someone that I would do it even if it were not well received.

God takes this very seriously. Recently, a Pastor who calls himself a Watchman shared some dreams that show things to come in America. They are harsh things. This man did what he should do by sharing these dreams. Watchmen are to give out the warning, even if they are ridiculed and scorned by those that think "everything is okay," or that he is a "false prophet." Prayer can change things my friends, but the warnings must come.

Many persons call those that give out warnings of judgement gloom and doom preachers, but that is absolutely contrary to the Word of God. They are Watchmen (and women) raised up by God to be his mouthpiece. Jesus could be called a Watchman because He spoke of what was to come.

The question is are we listening? Will you speak when Holy Spirit leads you? Will you be willing to give out a warning if all others turn against you? I pray the answer is yes, because that is the only way to be in the will of God! Be a Watchman for God.
