A PSALM 83 WAR

I have recently heard talk of a “Psalm 83 War.” I have looked at that Psalm to see what it is about. Keep in mind that many of the Psalms are prophetic. This psalm has prophesied what we have seen since 1948 when Israel once again became an independent nation.

Yea, let them be put to shame, and perish [so] that verse 18 men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth.”**

God has defended tiny Israel as they have defeated the attacks by multiple nations all simultaneously against all logical odds, and miraculously, in such a way that God alone could get the glory.
