In Song of Solomon, which really is a love story of Solomon towards the Shulamite woman, we see something about little things that can upset life. In chapter 2 verse 15 it says, "Take us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vines: for our vines have tender grapes."

The Amplified version reads this way, "[My heart was touched, and I fervently sang to him my desire] take us the foxes, the little foxes that spoil the vineyards [of our love], for our vineyards are in blossom."

The little things [foxes] were trying to spoil their love. It isn't always the big things that bring havoc into our lives. It is the little things, the little foxes that steal our peace, our joy, and eventually control us.

We must not allow these things to enter our "space." We must be determined to keep those things out of our lives. How do we do that?
