THE ANOINTING DESTROYS THE YOKE

In Isaiah 10:27 it says, ***“And it shall come to pass in that day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.”***

Often this verse is misquoted, and people say, “The anointing breaks the yoke.” There is a big difference between something broken and something destroyed. Something broken can be put back together again, but something destroyed is gone forever.

So, what is the anointing? It is the tangible presence of God upon a person. It is the Holy Spirit dwelling in and upon someone. The Holy Spirit operates through this person because they believe God’s word and promises are for them and act on them.

A yoke is being chained to another person or entity. There are yokes of bondage, and the anointing destroys that yoke. Remember, it doesn’t break it, it destroys it.
