SPEAK LIFE

In Deuteronomy 30:19 Moses is speaking to the nation of Israel, and says, ***“I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may life:”*** He spoke this shortly before he died. Last words are always important. Life and death are a choice. In Proverbs 18:21 it says, ***“Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit of it.”***

God wants life and life more abundantly for us. Our words bring life or death, cursing or blessing. In Revelation 1:16 it says, ***“...And out of his mouth went a sharp two-edged sword...”*** As Christians when we speak the Word of God, a two-edged sword comes out of our mouths. We use the Word of God like a sword, wielding it to bring victory. We are told in Hebrews 4:12, ***“For the word of God is quick (alive) and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.”*** We use the Word of God to cut away the things that are hindering us and others, or we use the word of God to bless others and ourselves. We must be very careful with our words, because again, it says in Proverbs 18:21 death and life are in the power of the tongue.

The Words we speak will determine the victory in our life. Many speak the opposite of what God promises in His word and wonder why they don't have health and prosperity. They continuously say they are sick, and broke, and things will not ever change. You can't have it both ways my friend. You either speak life or death. As it says in Hebrews 4:12, ***the word of God discerns the thoughts and intents of the heart.*** It brings us under conviction for speaking death instead of life.

It is a choice to speak life, just as it is a choice to speak death. We must clean up our words to line up with God's word. Then we will have victory. We receive healing through speaking life over ourselves. We receive finances through speaking life into it. What words do we speak? We speak the promises of God! Simple, yet profound. Let victory come through your mouth!
