JESUS' PRE-INCARNATE MANIFESTATIONS

PART 1 – THE SON

The incarnate Jesus was born of Mary as a baby and grew up into a man. “Carne” means meat in Spanish. It refers to flesh. God was born in flesh to Mary. That is why we call it the “incarnation” of Jesus Christ.

A “pre-incarnation” would be an appearance in the flesh or in human form before the birth through Mary.

The appearance of God in human form on earth is always Jesus (Jeshuah) who is the manifestation of God to us. The Father, (Jahh, Yahh) is 100% Spirit and never appears to us in human form. Only the Son (Jeshuah, Jesus) appears in physical form to man.

However, God has always shown himself to man in a physical way right from the Garden of Eden with Adam. This will be a short series to show you from scripture this particular truth which is not usually taught in most local churches.

As we go into this study, understand that the word LORD in all capital letters is always a form of Yahweh who are the trinity of Father (Yahh, or Jahh), Son, (Jeshuah, Jesus), and Holy Spirit. Only the Son (Jesus, Jeshuah) appears in human form to mankind.

God has always made himself known to us in one way or another. Whether as Yahweh (Jehovah) to his people, or as Elohiym to the world in general, but his fleshly (carnate) appearance has always been from God, the Son.
