NO DARKNESS AT ALL

Today I want to bring an exhortation about Christians and darkness. Today is the world's celebration of a pagan holiday, Halloween, which celebrates a demonic spirit, death, and the dark side. It should be a reasonable assumption for any practicing Christian to NEVER walk in the things of darkness. In I John 1:5 it says, ***"this then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all."*** Did you catch the last part? NO DARKNESS AT ALL.

We, as Christians, were placed into the body of Christ at conversion. Therefore, we are in the "light" because God is light. By bringing darkness into our lives, we are in rebellion against the things of God.

In John 8:12 it says, ***"Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, 'I am the light (not darkness) of the world: he that followeth me (you and I) shall not walk in darkness (things from the dark side), but shall have the light of life.'" We that follow Christ have to choose to not walk in darkness.***

You simply cannot have it both ways my friends. You have to make a choice. The things of darkness are not just "Halloween." There are many other dark things that we must never be involved in. Some of them are tarot card readings; playing with a Ouija board; seances; hypnotism; astrology; Astral projection; fortune telling; witchcraft of any sort; wicca; magic spells including "white magic;" horoscope readings; games on social media that are new age motivated; pornography; X-rated movies; video games that are violent; and more. You can't have light and darkness in the same body.

If you have been involved in any of the things above, you must repent. You must make the choice to NEVER be involved in them again. You must ask the Lord to forgive you for your sin and wash you with his blood. God is coming back for a church without spot or blemish. I dare to say that if you are "lukewarm" about the things of darkness that you might just miss out on being in His Kingdom. It isn't worth playing with the things of darkness as a child of God.

You may not like what I have chosen to share today, but the love that this ministry has for God overrides any criticism that we might receive. It is our responsibility as part of the five-fold ministry to tell you the truth. I pray that your eyes are opened to the truth, so you won't be deceived any longer. The truth may hurt, but the wound will heal.
