So often we are caught up in listening to another person give us direction rather than listen to Holy Spirit. In the days we are coming into, it is an absolute necessity that you fine tune your spiritual hearing so you can follow the voice of Holy Spirit. It may save your life or save another person's life. I can tell you so many stories how this has worked in my life, but this message isn't about me. It is about you and what you are doing with God's plan. Take time to be quiet and just wait upon the Lord to speak. He isn't impressed by noisy conversations where we do all the talking. He truly wants to lead us if we take time to listen.
