YOUR COMMISSION, AMBASSADOR: PART 1

Did you realize that you are appointed as an ambassador for Jesus Christ to speak, act, and do His works in His stead? Let us examine just what that means.

II Corinthians 5:20 says (KJV) ***“Now then we are ambassadors for Christ...”*** that means every believer represents Christ, or should represent Him, in all His fullness.

In Ephesians 6:19-20 Paul writes that even though he is in prison bonds, still he is an ambassador to speak boldly, making known the “good news” of the gospel.

What is an ambassador? It is a representative of the highest rank sent by one’s government (King, President, Prime Minister) to another ruler or government. It is just as if the “king” himself had decreed it. There can be no disputing the word spoken or given by the ambassador.

But what is it that you are to do or speak Mr./Mrs./Miss ambassador? Where are you to speak it or do it?

Ephesians 2:19 indicates that we are citizens of the household of God, the kingdom of heaven. We are sent as Christ’s ambassadors to the kingdoms of this world to declare the Word of God, to do the works that Jesus did, and to spread the gospel to all that would hear. We are the citizens of heaven speaking the will of King Jesus to the citizens on this earth.

Jesus said (Matthew 28:18-20), ***“all power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore and teach all nations...”*** This is commonly called “the Great Commission.” This is our first and foremost job as His ambassador. But there is much more to it.
