The "Beatitudes" given by Jesus are found in Matthew 5:3-12. The very last two of the "blessed" attributes are found in verses 10 and 11.

Verse 10 says, "Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven (to inherit)."

Verse 11 says, "Blessed are ye when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil (lies) against you falsely for my (names') sake."

In John 15:18 Jesus further says, "If the world hate you, ye know that it (they) hated me before it (they) hated you." He goes on to say that if you were conformed to those of the world they would love (accept) you because you are like them.
