RUSSELL SANDERS 1-4-2024 SAY SO

Psalm 107:2 says, "Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom He hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy (adversary)."

We are to "say so," meaning we are to tell others how God has redeemed us (bought us back) from the adversary, Satan, and how God saved us from the curse of death caused by sin. How will people know of redemption if we do not speak of it?

The word of our testimony is effective in at least two ways. First, it shows the way to salvation for the sinner. Second, it overcomes the work of Satan and defeats him.

Revelation 12:10-11 says, "...Now is come salvation, and strength, and the...power of His Christ, for the accuser of our brethren is cast down...overcome by the blood of the Lamb, and by the WORD OF THEIR TESTIMONY..."

That is why it is so important for the redeemed believers to "say so"!

Do not be shy or ashamed to speak out a word about your personal testimony. It is a word of life to all who hear it.
