Yesterday I wrote that we, the redeemed, are to "say so" that those around us may hear the testimony of the gospel. There is more to "say so." We are to "say so" unto God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. It is the sacrifice of praise that is supposed to come out of our mouth and from our heart (spirit).

In Hebrews 12:15 we read, "...let us offer therefore the sacrifice of praise to God continually (throughout the day) that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name."

Praise the Father (Jahh), the Son (Jeshuah, Jesus), and the Holy Spirit (sent from Father).

Love defines the Father. 1 John 4:8b says, "...God (Father) is love."
