HOW IS YOUR FAITH TEMPERATURE?

In the book of Hebrews it says, ...***“But without faith it is impossible to please him (God)...”*** Again, we see in the book of Habakkuk Ch. 2:4, ***“Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.”*** It is repeated in the New Testament in Hebrews 10:38 where it says, ***“Now the just shall live by faith: but if any many draw back my soul shall have no pleasure in him.”***

Faith is an absolute priority in a believer’s life. Yet, many don’t know how to get faith. The scriptures tell us, ***“So then, faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God.”*** (Romans 10:17) Just hearing the word of God can build up your faith.
