HALTING BETWEEN TWO OPINIONS

In I Kings 18 we see the story of Elijah confronting the prophets of Baal that had been brought into Israel by King Ahab's evil wife Jezebel. Elijah challenged the people to make a choice to follow Jehovah God or follow Baal. Whichever God would burn up a sacrifice would be the most powerful. In verse 21 it says, ***"And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt (dance, leap, skip) between two opinions? If the LORD be God, follow Him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word."***
