CONFIDENT

In Philippians 1:6 we are told that, ***“Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.”***

The word confident comes from the Greek word peitho which means to convince, to rely, to assure, to believe, to trust, to yield. In other words, we are convinced to trust God to do a work in us. He will do that work until either you go home to him, or he comes back. (Day of Jesus Christ.)

Proverbs 3:5-6 tells us, ***“Trust in the Lord with all thine heart and lean not unto your own understanding. 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him and he shall direct thy paths.”*** This is saying the same thing that Philippians 1:6 is saying.
