Psalm 133:1-2a says, "Behold, how good and how precious it is for brethren [all mankind] to dwell [live] together in unity. It is like the precious ointment (anointing) upon the head [of God's priestly ones] ..."

God desires that we all live together in harmony and unity. This is possible through the divinely given love [agape'] that He puts within the hearts of His people. He desires that we hold NO hard feelings toward anyone. Strife, contention, ill will, and anger are tools of the dark side and not of God, nor of His love for all mankind.

To harbor within yourself any of these feelings or offenses is sin. The word tells us that if we do not forgive, then we also will not be forgiven.

As verse one says, it is good and pleasant to live in harmony [unity] with one another. It brings a precious anointing upon our head [lives].

If you have any ill feelings about anybody, repent and give them to God. Do not hold on to them. It could perhaps bring damnation upon you.

We are to love everyone no matter how unlovable they may appear to be. Why? God loves every one of them, and we are to be a reflection of his love.

If there is someone whom you feel it is impossible for you to love, then give them to God and GET OVER IT! Repent!

Agape [Greek] love is a "God love" that is beyond human love. Ask God to give you that kind of love for all people.
