HELEN SANDERS 1-21-2024 GOD'S PROMISES ARE YES AND AMEN

The Apostle Paul writes in II Corinthians 1:20 *"For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him amen, unto the glory of God by us."* What exactly does this mean? You must dig for it. So, dig into the scriptures, and write down the promise you need, and then speak the promises over yourself. How long do you wait until the promise comes? You wait until it comes, and don't doubt that it is coming. It may take an hour, a week, a month, or years, but it is yours.

There will always be a test of your faith to see if you truly believe the promise is for you. Satan will try to rob the promise (word) from you, but let it be in your mouth until it is manifested. Remember all of God's promises are yes and amen!
