Romans 12:1-2 tells us, "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. <sup>2</sup> And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

We are to place our lives spiritually on the altar of God and present ourselves to God. We do this as an act of love, and we do it while we are still alive. It is a living sacrifice, not a sacrifice that involves physical death or self-inflicted flagellation [beating or cutting ourselves or causing physical harm to ourselves to get God to love us].
