I have lived through more than seven hurricanes. When the power went off and the sky was cloudy it kept any starlight or moonlight from shining through; it was the darkest dark, I had seen. There were no streetlights, no traffic lights, no signs lit upon the road. You could not see where you were if you did not know the area. If you did not have a flashlight or a candle or some other form of light like a lantern, you could not see your hand in front of you.

This is the kind of darkness that awaits those that do not know the Lord Jesus Christ. The scripture tells us this in Isaiah 60:2 where it says, *"For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people..."* There is no light in hell. It is a place of absolute darkness for eternity.

This darkness surrounds those that do not have the light of God in their lives. Isaiah 60:2 continues with, "... but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee. And the Gentiles (non-believers) shall come to thy light..."

Yes, we see darkness in the world, far darker than ever before, but we take the light of God, the glory of God and go into that darkness and people will be drawn to our light.

This is our greatest opportunity to the share the light of God with those that are lost and without hope. No matter what happens in the world, we have the blessed hope of eternal life with Jesus Christ, and we can share that blessed hope with others. There will be no darkness in our eternal home with Christ because he is the light that will shine, and that light is in us, so we shall shine also.

Have you shared his light with anyone? If not, do not put it off. Lives are waiting to see your light and come to it!
