A MESSIANIC TRILOGY

We conclude the study of the Messianic Trilogy of Psalms 22, 23, and 24 today.

Psalms 22-24 show the ultimate goal of the Father accomplished as His only begotten Son reigns over all the earth as King of Glory, and as the King of all Kings. This is fulfilled in part now in the present earth and in its completeness in the new earth of Revelation 21:1.

Psalms 24:1 declares that the *“earth is the Lord’s and the fullness thereof.”* It belongs to the LORD and nobody else. It declares that all that dwell on the earth belong to Him and to nobody else. Verses 3-6 speak of those who seek Him and stand in His holy place. Verses 7-10 exalt Messiah as the *“King of Glory.”* Good can only be conscribed to God, thus verifying that Messiah is God as one with the Father.

This is His eternal kingdom. Jesus won that victory with His resurrection from the grave and it culminates in the new earth. There He will truly reign as King of glory over the entire earth where there is no more evil.
