SEEING WHAT YOU SAY

When it comes to faith, it is received without seeing. You must see it in your spirit and believe that it is from God according to the scriptures. If we can see it then it doesn't take faith to receive it.

We are told in scripture in Hebrews 10:38, ***"Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back (from faith) my soul shall have no pleasure in him."*** This is a quote from the Book of Habakkuk 2:4 where it says, ***"... but the just shall live by his faith."***
