DWJD: PART 3

DWJD. **Do What Jesus Did.** Jesus decreed it. He spoke it. John 14:12, ***“...the works that I do shall (you) also do, and greater works than these shall (you) do.”***

Jesus said in (Matthew 28:18), ***“All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.”*** He also said (John 14:14), ***“If ye ask anything in my name, I will do it.”***

Jesus' power moves through the Holy Spirit's anointing upon us to “get it done.” Jesus gives the “word” and Holy Spirit acts upon it. We can see the Holy Spirit's creative activity in Genesis 1:2. The Father planned the design for the earth. He was the “master mind” of it. Jesus, The Word, spoke it into being. (John 1:1-3) The Holy Spirit then acted on the Word, moving upon the face of the earth (waters) to put it together. It took the full Godhead (Trinity) working together to bring the creation into being.

The same thing occurred for our redemption. The Father set forth the plan. The Word (Jesus) delivered Himself to the cross to set the plan in motion. The Holy Spirit then came to bring His life and power into us as seen in John 20:22 when Jesus appeared after His resurrection to the disciples. ***“He breathed upon them and saith unto them ‘Receive ye the Holy Ghost’.”*** His breath imparted the Holy Spirit unto salvation, activating the redemptive work in them. Later, at Pentecost, in the upper room they would be endued (imparted) with the special power and anointing of the Holy Ghost to do the works of Jesus.

It is through the anointing of the Holy Ghost that we draw Jesus' power to **Do What Jesus Did** here on earth. The Holy Spirit is the activator. We speak it in faith, in Jesus' name, and the Holy Spirit performs it.
