WHO DO YOU SAY I AM?

LESSON 4

Today we will consider the Trinity involved in the creation which is found in Genesis chapters 1 and 2. But first, we return to John 1:3 where it says of Jesus [the Word], ***“All things were made by him...”*** This tells us that the spoken word of Jesus resulted in the creation of all things. Let us look at the original Greek meaning of the KJV English word “by” him. The original word in Greek is “dia” which means “through,” therefore the accurate rendition is ***“all things were made through him.”*** as He spoke the Father’s design into existence.

The Father’s [the creative intelligence] creation design was received by Jesus, who then spoke the plan in detail. The Holy Spirit then acted upon the word and moved upon the world with the creative force to bring it into existence. Therefore, it truly was through Jesus that everything was made according to his all-powerful word. He really is The Word of Father God in every sense.

In Genesis 1:3; 6; 9; 14; 20; 24; and 26 each read, ***“and God said”*** for each creation day. This was Jesus speaking it all into creation. The Holy Spirit’s role is seen in verse 2 where it says, ***“And the Spirit moved upon the face of the waters”*** to prepare the earth to receive the creation. It clearly shows the Holy Spirit as the force who brings the spoken word of Jesus into physical reality.

Since everything was created through the spoken word of God, the Word [Jesus], when things get broken, who better to fix them than the original creator, Jesus? That is why when something seems to go wrong for you, that you should pray, and Jesus knows how to fix it.

Jesus is the part of the Godhead as God the Son, through whom everything was made or ever shall be made.
