12 Now this I say, that every one of you saith, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas (Peter); and I of Christ."

Divisions arose because they were following after a person instead of following after Christ. In 1 Corinthians 11:1 it says "Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ." In other words, follow the Christ in the person. When you follow Christ, and you cannot go wrong.
