YOUR PLACE IN HEAVEN

John 14:2-3 (NIV), Jesus says, ***“My Father’s house has many rooms....I am going there to prepare a place for you....I will come back and take you to be with me...”***

The KJV says “mansions”, but it doesn’t necessarily mean what we think of as a “mansion.” The original Greek word is “mone” (mon-ay’) which means “a place to stay” or “residence” or “abode” or “dwelling place.” We don’t know what this might look like, but the meaning is ***“I go to make room for you so that where I am, you will also be there.”*** His promise is that He will come back for us to take us up in the first resurrection.

That is a glorious promise. Paul admonishes us to be faithful to the end. Whether we are taken up before the Great Tribulation or whether we go through it with persecution and torture, we must never turn our back on Jesus or deny Him. Our faithfulness in either case will be eternally rewarded. To deny Jesus, deny our faith, would cost us everything. Hell is forever, also.

God does not wish for anyone to be eternally lost. We have a good Father. Jesus, our Lord is from eternal into eternity. He will take care of us. He will make sure to keep all of us whom the Father has given Him. He has prepared a very special and beautiful place for you and me.
